CITY COUNCIL EXECUTIVE SESSION
JULY 7, 2016

An Executive Session of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Brian Blad at 11:00 a.m. in the Paradise Conference Room at City Hall. Council members present were Roger Bray, Steve Brown, Jim Johnston, Gary Moore and Michael L. Orr.
