- **SWEEPING:**

Sweeping will be done based on the micro seal schedule below.

- **MICRO SEALING**

V.S.S. will begin micro sealing the following streets as set forth below this week. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

- **TREE TRIMMING**

Street Operations will continue trimming overgrown trees on roads receiving a treatment this season. These services may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed.

- **PAVEMENT MARKINGS & ROAD STRIPING**

Street Operations Department will continue striping roads and refreshing crosswalks this week. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being done.

- ➔ **WATER DEPARTMENT**

- **WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT**

The City of Pocatello Water Department will continue replacing the water mainline on Lincoln Ave from West Clark Street heading southeast toward Bonneville Street. Crews will work between the hours of 7:00 AM to approximately 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while work is being performed. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties

- **JETTING SEWER LINES**

Crews will be jetting sewer lines throughout the city. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

- ➔ **IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

- **NIGHT CONSTRUCTION ON YELLOWSTONE AVENUE BETWEEN THE INTERSECTIONS OF CEDAR STREET AND FLANDRO DRIVE**

Starting July 22, 2020, between 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM, night work will take place while crews begin re-paving the roadway. The milling and paving will first begin on the outer lanes running south and then north along the curb line. Work will then include milling from the inside lane to the centerline of the road. Work is anticipated to be completed by August 30<sup>th</sup>. There will be intermittent evening road closures at Industrial Lane, West Griffith Road, West Chapel Road, East Chapel Road, Pearl Street, and East Griffith Road. Temporary traffic control will be set-up and nightly traffic detours will be in effect during the time of construction. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.
