• **MILLING & PAVING**

- **Monday, August 31 & Tuesday, September 1**
Street crews will be milling and paving North Harrison Avenue from West Connor Street to West Carson Street. No parking will be allowed on the street from 6:30 am until work is completed that day. Construction will require closing this section of North Harrison Avenue as work is performed. Motorists are advised to expect delays in this area and to use alternate routes.
- **Wednesday, September 2 & Thursday, September 3**
Street crews will be milling and paving West Whitman Street from Main Street to the Harrison Alley. No parking will be allowed on the street from 6:30 am until work is completed that day. Construction will require closing this section of West Whitman Street as work is performed. Motorists are advised to expect delays in this area and to use alternate routes.

• **PAVEMENT MARKINGS**

Street Operations Department will continue refreshing crosswalks and pavement markings this week. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being done.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT

The City of Pocatello Water Department will be replacing water lines along East Dunn Street starting on South 2nd Avenue and continuing towards South 7th Avenue beginning Monday, August 31. The project is expected to take approximately four weeks to complete. Crews will work the hours of 7:00 am to approximately 5:00 pm, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and traffic will be reduced down to one lane while work is being performed.
