- **CRACK SEALING**

Street Operations will be performing crack sealing throughout the city this week. Treatment will require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

**WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT**

The City of Pocatello Water Department will continue replacing water lines along East Dunn Street starting on South 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and continuing towards South 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The project began August 31, and is expected to take approximately four weeks to complete. Crews will work the hours of 7:00 am to approximately 5:00 pm, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and traffic will be reduced down to one lane while work is being performed.
