• **MILLING & PAVING**

The Pocatello Street Department will begin milling & paving the following streets beginning Monday, October 19 through Wednesday, October 21. No parking will be allowed on the street from 6:30 am until work is completed that day. Construction will require closing the road as work is performed. Motorists are advised to expect delays in the area and to use alternate routes.

• **PAVEMENT MARKINGS & ROAD STRIPING**

Street Operations Department will continue striping roads and refreshing crosswalks this week. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being done.

• **SIGNAL WORK**

Crews will be performing signal work at the West Eldgredge and Pole Line Rd intersection on Tuesday, October 20th. Motorists may experience delays or intermittent lane closures while crews are performing the work.

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT

Crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will start replacing water main lines on East Lovejoy Street. The project areas will be between South 1st Avenue and South 2nd Avenue as well as South 3rd Avenue and South 4th Avenue. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and approximately 5:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday for three weeks. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of street will be completely closed while workers are digging. However, every effort will be made to provide local access when possible. Parking will also be restricted, and residents are asked to park all vehicles outside the construction zone during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.
