• **PAVEMENT MARKINGS & ROAD STRIPING**

Street Operations Department will continue striping roads and refreshing crosswalks this week. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being done.

• **MILLING & PAVING**

Monday, September 27 through Thursday, September 30

Street crews will be milling and paving the following streets:

- **N Grant Ave** from W Custer St to W Day St
- **W Carson St** from N Grant Ave, west to the bridge
- **W Greeley St** from N Grant Ave, east appx 30 ft
- **W Young St** from N Grant Ave to the N Grant Alley

No parking will be allowed on the streets from 6:30 am until work is completed each day. Roads will be closed while crews are working in the area. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the work areas.

WATER LINE INSTALL

Crews with the City of Pocatello Water Department will continue working on North Grant Avenue. The total project area will span over 4,500 feet on North Grant Avenue from Center Street to West Day Street. During the project, road closures and detours will occur. Motorists are asked to use alternate routes when possible. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Access to the construction area will be

restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.
