• **PAVEMENT MARKINGS & ROAD STRIPING**

Street Operations Department will continue striping roads and refreshing crosswalks this week. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being done.

• **CRACK SEALING**

Street Operations will be performing crack sealing throughout the city this week. Treatment will require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays.

• **CROSS DRAIN REPLACEMENT-Monday, October 4**

Street Operations will be replacing the cross drain on the east side of the E Walnut St and Filmore Ave intersection. This will require the 1000 block of E Walnut St to be closed to thru traffic while crews are working. Motorists are asked to use alternate routes and expect delays in the area.

• **RAISING MANHOLES**

Street crews will be raising storm water manholes throughout the city this week. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays.

**WATER LINE INSTALL**

Crews with the City of Pocatello Water Department will continue working on North Grant Avenue. The total project area will span over 4,500 feet on North Grant Avenue from Center

Street to West Day Street. During the project, road closures and detours will occur. Motorists are asked to use alternate routes when possible. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. However, every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.
